The Busan Metropolitan City, the host city of the IGC 2024, is located within the Cretaceous Gyeongsang Basin, and a variety of geologic and tectonic history from the Cretaceous to the present day is recorded in the Busan. Busan became a national geopark in 2013, with a total of 20 geosites, including Nakdonggang Estuary, Taejongdae, Geumjeongsan, and so on.
